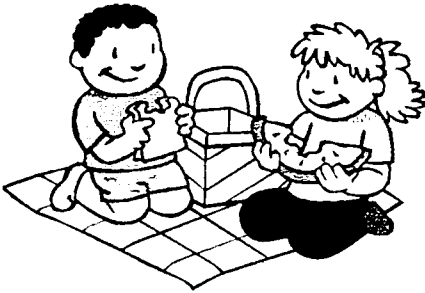

Den 7 – dessert

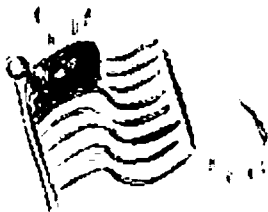
Den 6 and Den 3 – salad

Den 4 – chips (our new Tiger Cubs)

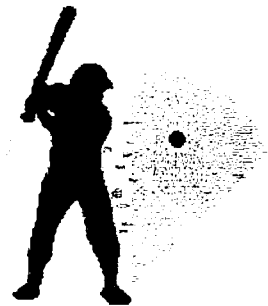
Fourth of July

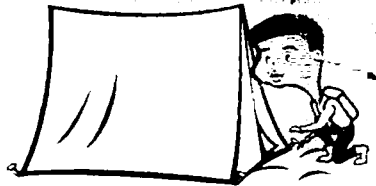
