



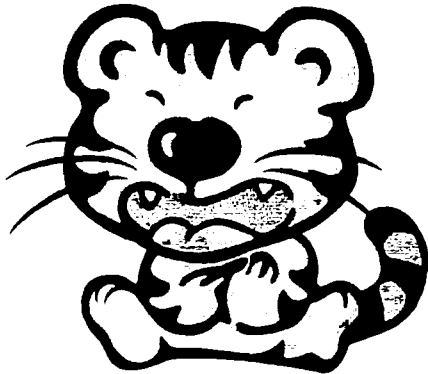

GOLDEN GOPHERS

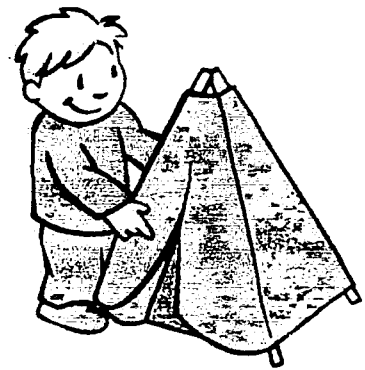

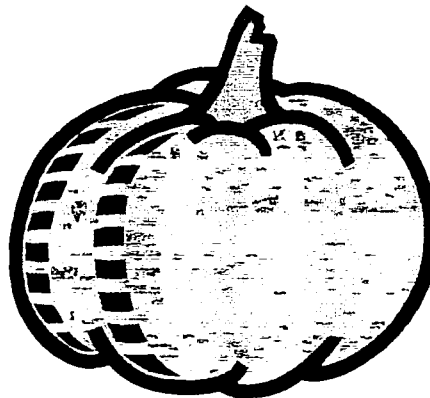
Way to go Scouts!!!
